





Re: ICAGeorgia Reading Challenge Grade 2

Reading Challenge is a school program which encourages students to find a passion for reading. Students are required to read 20 minutes each day as part of their homework. The goal for your child is to read 60 books/chunks independently this year. A chunk consists of 50 pages from a chapter book. Every chunk completed counts as 1 book. Students may also read picture books. Each picture book counts as 1 book.

Once our child finishes reading a book, he/she will record the book read in the E-Reading Log which is located online, then choose and complete the appropriate book report. Please refer to Reading Challenge on the Academics Page of the school's website to print more copies throughout the year:

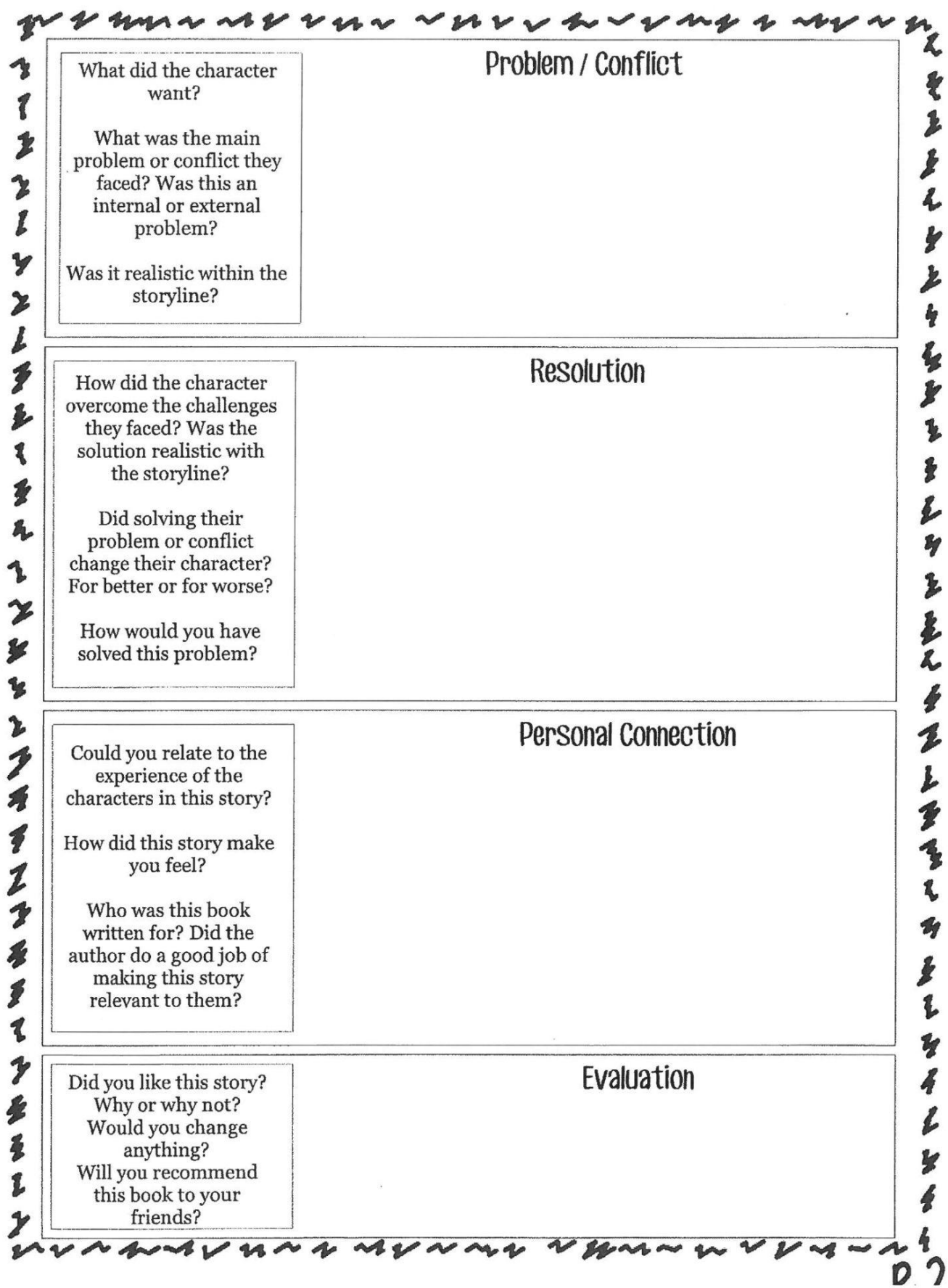

Who was this book written for? Did the author do a good job of making this story relevant to them?

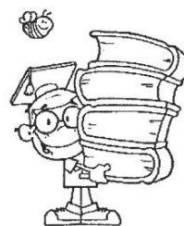
